



## Participant Agreement

*Friends of Appalachia, Inc. (FOA) is a Trumbull, Connecticut based Community Organization, open to all, which strives to educate and sensitize youth and adult volunteers to address the needs of the impoverished people in Central Appalachia.*

*We will be participating in the Appalachia Service Project (ASP) and supporting Kids First Dental Care, Mission of Hope and other Appalachian organizations.*

Each person's talents and efforts are essential to help the impoverished people of Central Appalachia. All participants are expected to make the following commitments:

- 1. Attend ALL meetings**
- 2. Meet ALL due dates**
- 3. Participate in ALL fundraising activities**
- 4. Submit FOA forms & deposit by January 10 (participants who submit forms & deposits after Jan. 10 will be placed on a waiting list)**
- 5. Financial obligation of at least \$750 (\$50 due Jan 10; \$200 due Feb 28; \$200 due Mar 28; \$200 due May 2; \$100 due Jun 6)**
- 6. Sell at least 2 ads for the Ad Book (due February 28)**
- 7. Submit at least one \$25 (minimum value) gift certificate for the raffle (due February 28)**
- 8. Participate in at least one grocery store fundraiser (March, April, May)**
- 9. Participate in construction training/project(s) (dates/hours to be determined)**
- 10. Submit ASP trip forms by May 2 (if participating in the trip)**

The times, dates and locations of these activities will be made known to all participants. It is the responsibility of each participant to complete all activities on time. A record of participation will be maintained for each participant.

- A spirit of cooperation, a respectful attitude, and consideration for others are all-important to the success of FOA activities. I agree to bring such an attitude to all FOA activities.
- I agree to abide by ALL of the rules established by FOA, ASP and leaders.
- I agree to refrain from the use of tobacco products, energy drinks, alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs during all FOA/ASP activities (and during the entire ASP trip).
- I agree to show consideration for people; maintain decorum during meetings; wear appropriate clothing; behave appropriately and will not participate in any illegal activities.
- On the ASP trip, I agree to stay with the group at all times; allow others to sleep by being quiet; use only approved electronic devices; wear a seatbelt at all times when in transit and observe lights-out rules. I will not participate in any gambling activities or buy/possess fireworks.
- On the ASP trip, I agree to attend all activities scheduled by the ASP Center Staff. I agree to be in a spirit of community with the other groups who will share the Center.

Advisors only: I will lead by example and enforce all FOA & ASP Rules, Regulations and Expectations.

I understand that if I violate any of these rules, I may be dismissed from FOA activities. If on the ASP trip, I may be sent home immediately at my own expense. If a youth participant is dismissed, parents/guardians must arrange for all transportation and accompany the youth home.

I AGREE TO COMPLETE EACH OF THE REQUIRED ACTIVITIES. I AGREE TO HAVE FUN, TO WORK HARD, AND TO DO MY BEST TO HELP THE PEOPLE OF APPALACHIA AND BRING AN ENTHUSIASTIC SPIRIT TO THE MISSION OF FRIENDS OF APPALACHIA, INC.
